April 2023 TMC Scholarship Program Office Application Requirements

Soshi Educational Group Tokyo Management College Global Study Center recruits students as following. This program is for those who wish to study Japanese language in Japan and find a job afterwards, as scholarship students, with the hope that they will become internationally active student.

1. Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to contribute to the development of students who want to study Japanese language in Japan and improve their career. For this reason, scholarships will be provided to foreign exchange students who received a letter of recommendation from a Japanese language education institution or from a teacher who belongs to (or was belonging to) the institution.

2. Recruitment qualifications

Those who correspond to all of the following conditons:

- (1) A person who received Japanese language education at a Japanese language school institution or high school / college / university.
- (2) A person who read the application guidelines carefully, filled out the format (resume) prepared by our school, and sent it to the designated address.
- (3) A person who received a letter of recommendation from a Japanese language school institution, etc., or from a teacher who belongs to (or was belonging to) that institution when submitting the documents mentioned above.
- (4) A person who can study in Japan from April 2023.
- (5) A person who com obtain a student visa in Japan;
- (6) A person who will follow the rules, set by the school.
- (7) TMC Scholarship program applicants should be either native English speakers or be able to speak English at a native level. And also they must have a Japanese level of N3 or above.

3. Grant of Certificate of Completion

Those who have studied Japanese at the Global Study Center for one year will receive a Certificate of Academic Achievement.

4. Tuition exemption for the scholarship students

The regular annual fee is: Tuition 600,000 yen + Entrance fee 90,000 yen + Textbooks fee 90,000 yen
+ Facility maintenance fee 50,000 yen ⇒ Total of 830,000 yen

TMC Scholarship program:

SOSHI scholarship students are exempt from the annual tuition fee of 600,000 yen

The entrance fee 90,000 yen + The Textbooks fee 90,000 yen + The facility maintenance fee 50,000 yen

⇒ Total of 230,000 yen becomes the actual student expenses.

5. Payment period

One year from April 1, 2023 to the end of March 2024

6. Application Procedures

Download and fill out the application form from the website, attach it to an e-mail with a letter of recommendation from the Japanese language institution you belong to (or did), and reply to the designated address.

7. Application documents

- (1) Resume (with an ID photo)
- (2) Letter of recommendation

8. Deadline for submission of application documents

From October 7, 2022 to November 30, 2022 at noon (Japan time). We will stop taking applications once all the places are filled.

If the deadline is over or the submitted documents are incomplete, we will not accept your application. In addition, submission documents will not be returned.

9. Procedures of selection

The president of TMC will consult with the selection committee established at the school for those who have applied according to paragraph 6. The selection committee decides which candidates are eligible for the interview stage. The results will be sent to applicants by e-mail. An interview will be held around December 2022 and a final decision will be made after two weeks. The visa application procedures will follow after.

10. Scholars' Duties

- (1) The prospective student for this scholarship must promptly submit the admission documents and obtain a visa.
- (2) The student must enter Tokyo Management College Global Study Center in April 2023
- (3) For the TMC Scholarship program, you must live in the school's dormitory (Soshi Global House) during your enrollment period.
- (4) The student must be involved in the following activities:
 - 1) Become a teaching assistant for English classes at TMC, and/or make special lectures in your native language on/off campus within 12 hours a week.
 - 2) Participate in school events and internal/external cultural exchange activities and clubs.
 - 3) Help with the school's social media including translation/interpretation for more than three hours a week.

11. About Global Study Center

Global Study Center has both morning and afternoon classes. The student will be enrolled in either the morning or the afternoon classes, depending on their level of Japanese.

Morning classes 9:10 to 12:20

Afternoon classes 13:10 to 16:20

5 days a week, Semester System (Spring/Fall), 1 semester has about 20 weeks

※ Annual school days in 2020: 208 days (including special lectures)

12. Suspension or termination of scholarship payment

If the scholarship student falls under any of the following criteria (1) to (6), the scholarship will be canceled and they must pay the full amount of money back.

- (1) In the case that the attendance rate in class falls below 95%.
- (2) In the case of failure of the scholars' duties.
- (3) In the case that you violate the school rules.
- (4) In the case that there is a false statement in the application / recommendation documents.
- (5) In the case that you do not correspond to these requirements mentioned above.
- (6) In the case of TMC deciding that the student is not qualified for the scholarship.

13. Student Dormitory (Soshi Global House)

(1) Dormitory expenses are not included in this scholarship, and if you enter the dormitory, the cost will be paid to a double room (45,000 yen per month) or a quadruple room (30,000 yen per month).

In addition, admission fee (30,000 yen), security deposit (10,000 yen), futon fee (15,000 yen) are separately required regardless of which room you want.

(2) In the case of entering in the dormitory, it is necessary to pay in advance three months' worth of dormitory expenses together with the tuition fees.

※ For Soshi internship program, you must live in the school's dormitory. For the TMC KIZUNA Scholarship course, applicants can choose whether they would like to stay in the school dormitory or not.

※ The dormitory is a 20-year-old property, and it has a shared kitchen, shower room and toilet room.

※ The Internet is included in the dormitory fee.

15. Other (Notes)

(1) After completing the one-year scholarship period, those who wish to advance to the second year can continue their studies at TMC by paying the second-year payment (740,000 yen). If the applicant would like to extend their scholarship period, they can do so after a review from the school.

(2) In the case of one-year study abroad, regardless of expiring date of the residence card, you have to leave Japan by April 30th 2024 after the completion of the program.

(3) If an intern decides to withdraw from the program before its completion for personal reasons, they must depart from Japan immediately and will not receive any refunds.

(4) A person who falls under paragraph 12 and had their scholarship revoked must immediately give up their visa and leave Japan.

(5) TMC has no responsibility for the delay by the Immigration Bureau of Japan in issuing the Certificate of Eligibility (COE). There will be no reduction of cost associated with the delay.

(6) Interns may be accepted not only at TMC but also at the Tokyo International Business College (TIBC) within Soshi Educational Group.

16. Protection of personal information

The personal information on the application / recommendation letter is used only for the student's purpose by the school and not for any other purposes.
